2025 Spring Training Stadium Map

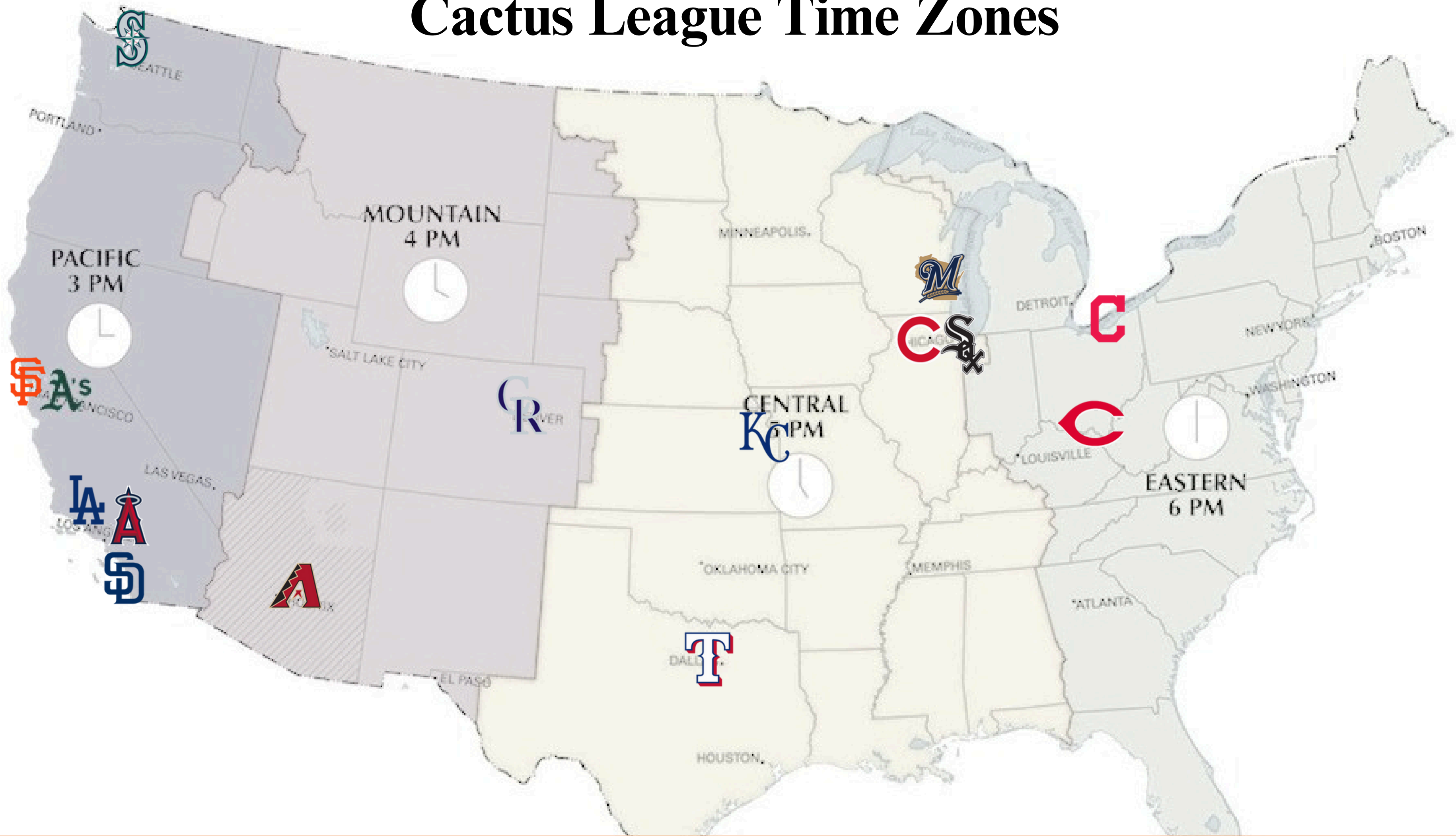
