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INTRODUCTION

The West Valley of Greater Phoenix continues to be one of the fastest growing regions in the country. Comprised of 15 communities encompassing 3,000 square miles west of Interstate 17, the region is home to 1.8 million residents ranging from established corporate executives to an up-and-coming millennial workforce. The median age is 36.2 years with 64% of residents being workforce age. The West Valley is also one of the most culturally diverse regions in Arizona and well known for our minority-majority population of 58%.

Over the past two decades, this region has attracted young families, an experienced work force, Fortune 500 companies, luxury housing communities, world-class sports and entertainment amenities, all adding to a high quality of life for residents and continued growth. To meet the employment needs of this region, WESTMARC has worked with economic development teams, the business community and education partners to develop and implement a regional strategic plan for workforce development – West Valley Pipeline Workforce Development Strategy. This plan was developed in 2017, with an updated version (West Valley Pipeline 2.0) recently completed in 2023.



PURPOSE

The West Valley Regional Workforce Development Strategy – West Valley Pipeline – covered the years 2018 - 2023 to qualify and quantify the region's current workforce, and to work with industry to ensure the ongoing development of a workforce pipeline to attract more high quality, high paying career opportunities for regional residents.

The Strategy was updated (version 2.0) for the years 2024 – 2028 with the continued emphasis of ensuring that local businesses have access to quality talent pipelines that will allow for profitability and expansion. Additionally, quality of life and family goals such as access to childcare, housing, and transportation have been added to ensure workforce solutions are approached holistically.

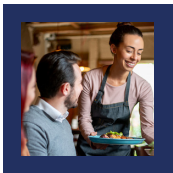

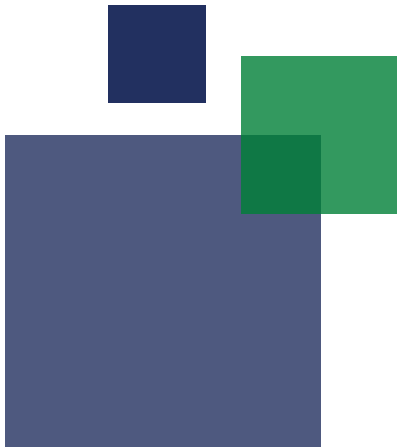

DATA

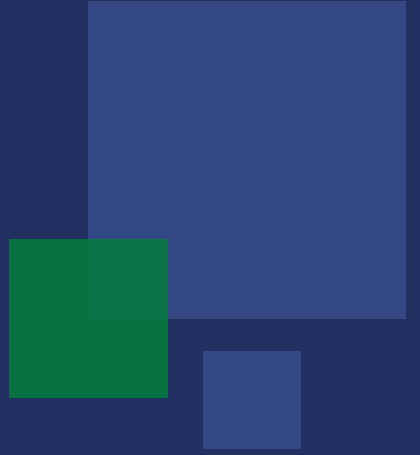
